One of our intentions for these Adorations is to give us the rulers most conducive to helping bring our Lord's social reign here on earth.

However, we also need strength and conviction during this time and where better to find it than in prayer? A world in confusion and chaos needs men truly formed the principles of our Lord. A Christian author has said, "A chaotic mind is always awestruck by an orderly one; violence is impotent before fearlessness; moral or social anarchy very soon yields to a Will firmly set toward what is right, a way of life that tends steadily toward men's betterment." Our age needs to see men grounded in the spiritual life; our age is yearning for something deeper than just the material world. A man of real prayer can help those who are truly searching and can lead them to the knowledge of the Truth. Let us take advantage of these Adorations so that others may profit from them.

ALL-ADORATION


We will have All-Day Adoration this coming Saturday. The intentions for the Adorations will be:
