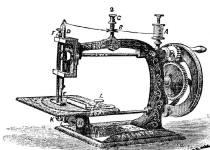

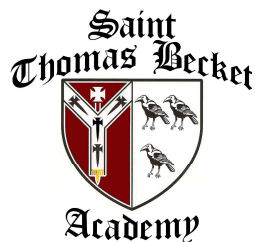

This Wednesday, Friday and Saturday are the fall Ember Days. These days are traditionally days of fast and partial (full on Friday) abstinence.

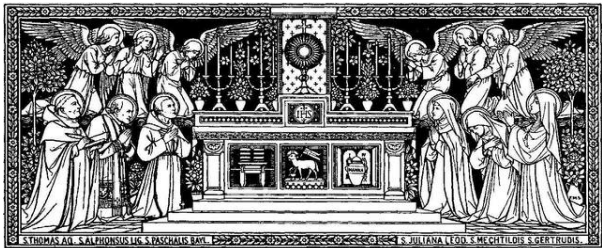
SECOND COLLECTION
